There are different forms that apply to different people. All are available on elohimnet. You are correct - the apostasy is for those who were baptized. There are, however, (again, on elohimnet) other forms. 4 in total. They are designed precisely to address this issue you raise here.

I would send them to all of you but I prefer we all go to elohimnet more. They are in file area/public/transmission. As well, there are other docs that we should all read regularly there. ;-)

1 is for Jewish people (who would always refuse to leave their Jewish roots and Our Prophet explained that they are actually becoming *more* Jewish)
1 is for others (not Jewish and not baptized into any religion)
1 for atheists
1 is for non-Christians (except Jews and Atheists) ie Muslims etc

So everyone is covered. ;-)

dear friends

As this happened while I was NG, I am writing to try to fix it. (still...hehe)

As it is ultimately my responsibility, I am personally going thru all the apostasies from past years again because I'm trying to find some missing inputs from Oct 7, 2006 (not 2007) because 2 TCPs were not entered on elohimnet on that date. (1.5 years ago) 17 were reported by all of you but only 15 were entered on elohimnet. I am very sure you all did the TCPs you told me you did but there's no way to find which piece of data is wrong here.

Realistically, none of our memories will remember who, where, what dates for TCPs. THAT'S why we have apostasy forms and elohimnet. That's why we use paper and computers. Agreed? :-)

So...how can I say what needs to be said delicately because I can tell you, I'm not happy about having to ask again. But I will try - again.

1) We must all make sure that these apostasies are filled out properly. Never, ever, ever, ever go over these apostasies "lightly". If it weren't so terrible it would be funny. Sometimes the date is wrong, sometimes there is no last name, sometimes there is no date at all etc. These must be accurate and readable. (!!!!!)

2) you must enter the TCPs on elohimnet the same evening. No exceptions. If within 24 hours your TCPs you called Lara with are not entered on elohimnet, Lara and I will really have no choice but to ask the discipline council to meet with you to help you understand how important this is because I have asked this at least 10 times over the past couple of years and it is still being forgotten.

3) apostasies must be sent to Jayq within 3 days. Because: Equally as bad, not all apostasies were sent to Jayq as I requested. I can say this for certain for Oct 7, 2006. (not 2007, but 06) There were 17 TCPs reported by all of you that day yet there were only 11 apostasies sent to Jayq. Yet there were 15 entered on elohimnet. So while I am very sure you all did the TCPs you told me you did, there is no way to confirm this, NOR is there a way to start to unscramble this egg. So you start to see the mess. And since I can say this is true for the only date I am searching, I am afraid it is also true for other TCP dates. The only solution is to send to Jayq *immediately*. (again, Discipline council will be happy to help you remember if you forget)

Please, as fantastic as ALL of you are, (and you are!!) it is urgent that you take this very seriously. I know it is a celebration day and we all want to do just that - celebrate! :-) But - - let's be sure to remember exactly what we're celebrating - the saving of more genetic codes. Codes/people/human beings **who are very often lost unless we keep track of them!!!**
