And for all structure related little businesses, we will have "White Knights".... Not to be confused with white nights although being a white knight could end up with a lot of white nights.

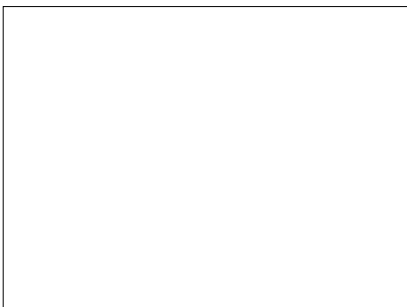
This newsletter will be available only through intranet so make sure you pop in regularly to have the latest news.

China

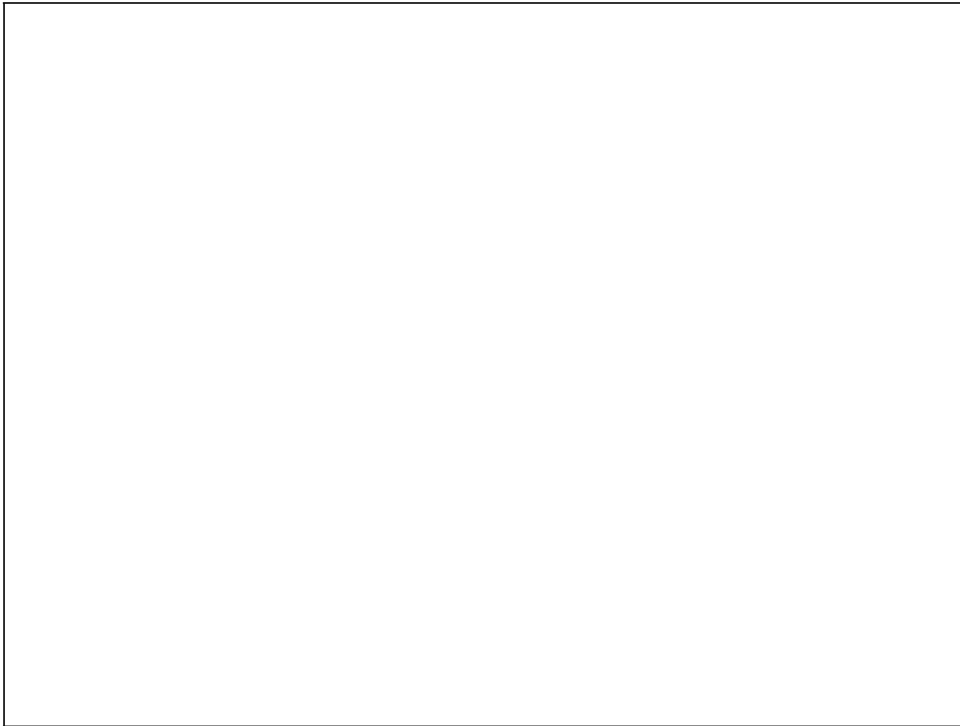

Beside the great time we had that October 7th on the beach of the great Lake Michigan in Chicago, I thought it would be interesting for you to know that we had 3 cellular plan transmissions and that all 3 are the results from diffusion with our posters at festivals, 1 from the air show in August, the other from the taste festival in June and the last one at the Chinatown festival 1.5 year ago. The poster-on-a-stick in festivals is a diffusion technique that works pretty well... Jerry just tried this technique and, as responsible of diffusion in US, I hope others will join him.
